

## Dangers of UVR

If UVR is allowed to fall on eyes, conjunctivitis may occur. To prevent this, the therapist always wears a protective goggle when the lamp is ON.

The patient is also provided with goggles or his eyes are screened using cotton wool.

## Over Dose :

The patient may receive stronger dose than the previous dose due to several factors these include:-

Using a different lamp with stronger output  
Moving a lamp closer to the patient giving a more intense dose.

Change in patient drug regimen.  
Poor time technique.

## Contraindications →

Acute skin conditions - Ex dermatitis

Deep X-ray therapy - It produces hypersensitivity to UVR and patients do not treated with UVR following DXT.

Photoallergy Allergic to UVR

Acute fibril illness

Recent skin grafting
