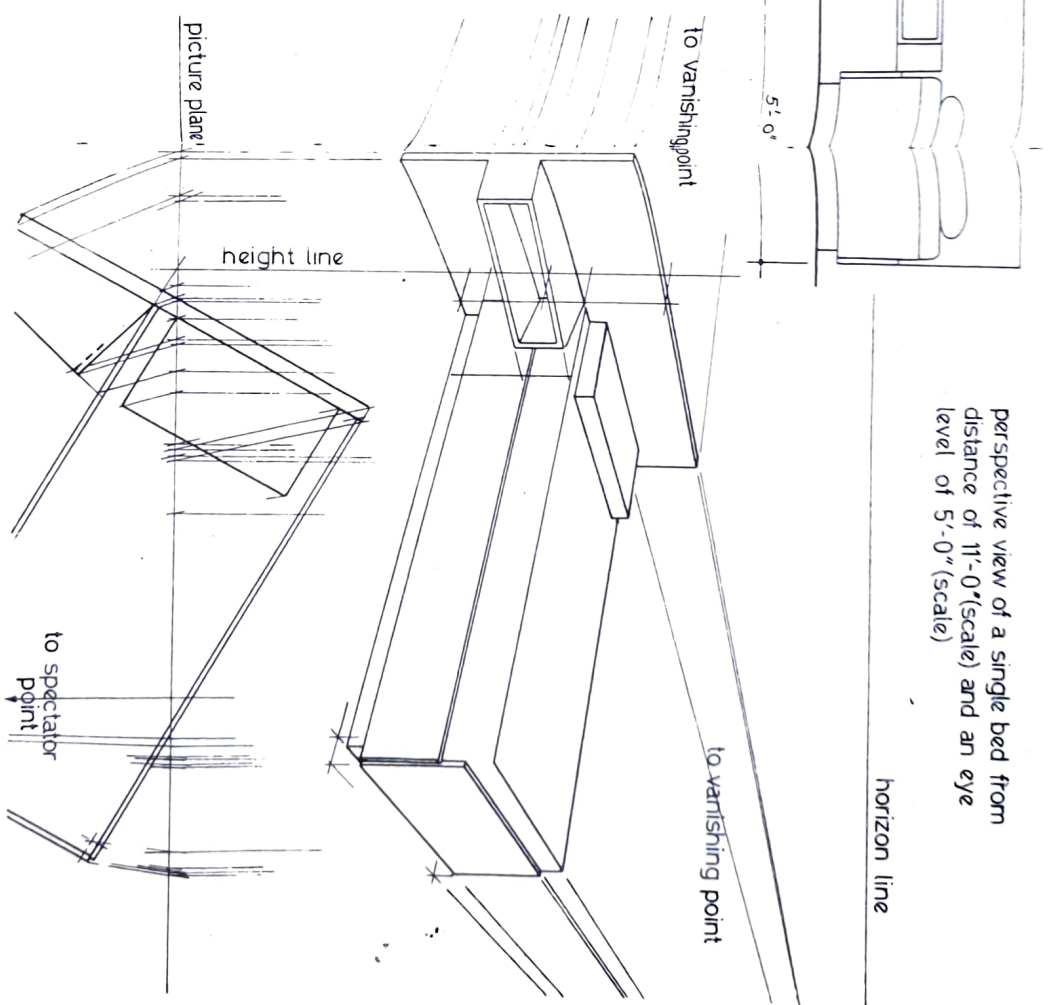


PLAN AND ELEVATIONS OF A SINGLE BED

DRAWING BEDS, WARDROBES AND DRESSING-TABLES

Similarly, such pieces of furniture as a bed, a wardrobe or a dressing-table are basically boxes and should be treated as such. Figure 77 shows an example of a single bed and bed-head drawn in plan and elevation as well as a perspective drawing using the plan as previously described. Figure 78 shows four examples of beds with various methods of drawing bedspreads, which, as can be seen, form an important part of drawing beds.
