Landscape

Landscape Painting depicts the scenery of the natural world with the views that impact the <u>artists eye</u>. In an effort to represent the beauty that meets the eye, the artist tries to capture that fleeting moment in time and space, for all time, thus becoming a co-creator with the original <u>Creator</u>.

In these visions may be, any element that may be natural or man-made. Flora and <u>fauna</u>, the weather, <u>light</u> and darkness all can play a part. There may or may not be, form and color, for even the lack of it shows the painter's perception in the quest for artistry.

Landscape paintings also aren't necessarily limited to depictions of land. For example, they can also include images of seascapes, cloudscapes, skyscapes, riverscapes, or cityscapes (otherwise known as "urban landscapes"). The main unifying element of any of these *-scape* artworks is that they all center around some kind of scenery.
