Top Management

- Top management includes:
 - Board of Directors.
 - Managing Director
 - Chief Executives
 - General Managers.
 - Owners
 - Share holders/Financiers.
- Top Management Functions are:
 - Setting basic goals and objectives.
 - Expanding on contracting activities.
 - Establishing policies
 - Monitoring performance
 - Designing/Redesigning organisation system
 - shouldering financial responsibilities.

Upper Middle level Management

- Upper middle level Management includes:
 - Sales Executive (Managers)
 - Production Executive.
 - Finance executive.
 - Account Executive.
 - R&D executives.
- Upper Middle Management Functions are:
 - Establishment of the organisation.
 - Selection of staff for lower levels of management.
 - Installing different departments.
 - Designing operating policies and routine.
 - Assigning duties to their subordinates.

Middle Management

- Middle Management includes
 - Superintendents
 - Branch Manager
 - General Foreman
- Middle Management Functions are
 - To cooperate to run organisation smoothly.
 - To understand interlocking of department in major policies.
 - To achieve coordination between different parts of the organisation.
 - To conduct training for employee development.
 - To build an efficient company team spirit.

Lower Management

- Lower Management includes:
 - Foreman
 - Supervisor
 - Office superintendent
 - Inspectors.
- Lower management functions are:
 - Direct supervision of workers and their work.
 - Developing and improving work method and operation.
 - Inspection function.
 - Imparting instruction to workers.
 - To give finishing touch to the plans and policies of top management.
 - To act as a link between top management and the operating force.
 - To communicate the feeling of workers to the top management.

Operating force

- Operating force includes:
 - Workers
 - Rank workers
 - File workers
 - Skilled workers
 - Semi-skilled workers
 - Unskilled workers
- Operating force functions are
 - To do work on machine or manually, using tools, etc.
 - To work independently (in case of skilled workers) or uner the guidance of supervisor.
