Specification helps in the calculation of the total cost of the project including cost of labour, materials, equipment, etc.


It guides the contractor in every aspect of the construction work.

Specification helps the contractor to fill the correct rate of work in the tender.

In construction work, there are two types of specification-

- 1-General Specifications.
- 2- Detailed Specifications.



General Specifications

General Specifications are the short description documents of everything which are going to be used in the construction work like equipment, materials, labours, etc.

General Specification helps to prepare the rough estimation cost of the construction work.

The general specification is not part of the contract documents.

Detailed Specifications

Detailed specifications are the detailed description documents of works that specify the qualities, quantities and proportion of materials.

It also specifies the method of preparation and execution and the method of measurements of the work.

The detailed specification is an important part of the contract document, and it is a legal document for court suits.

The detailed specification of different items of work is prepared separately.
