#### Children

- 1. The child has acceptance for justice & expectation of justice
  - The child expects justice (in every interaction with everyone, unconditionally)
- 2. The child speaks truth, has a desire to know truth
  - The child has a desire to understand the truth, about everything, right upto the whole existence (this is not an acquired need, it is innate)
  - The child willingly makes effort to understand (asks lots of questions)
  - The child can understand (once the child understands something, it follows)
- 3. The child has desire to have right behaviour, work & participation
  - The child wants to learn & behave with justice
  - The child wants to learn & work in accordance with natural laws
  - The child wants to participate in larger order
  - The child willingly makes effort to learn & he/she can learn

#### **Self reflection**
