## Methods of Studying Social Behaviour

#### Scientific in nature

- set of values (accuracy, objectivity, scepticism, open mindedness)
- set of methods

- EXPERIMENTATION
- SYSTEMATIC OBSERVATION
- FIELD STUDY
- SURVEY
- CORRELATION

 SYSTEMATIC OBSERVATION: a method of research in which behaviour is systematically observed and recorded

#### SYSTEMATIC OBSERVATION

- Selection of a behaviour to be studied
- Recording of behaviour
- Analysis of observations

#### SYSTEMATIC OBSERVATION

- researcher simply observes and not change the behaviour being

observed

- tries not to influence the observed (remaining hidden, unseen, imperceptible)

SYSTEMATIC OBSERVATION

ADVANTAGE: behaviour studied in real settings

- LIMITATION: not very cost effective
