


Gender Asymmetry




No one is unequal on the basis of their gender.



Feminist Research

When deciding a research topic:


If working on an issue of conservation talk to the women and children who carry water from long distances.

When deciding a Sample:

Plan to work with more sections of people.

When collecting Data:

Don't let one group get over represented in your research.



Data Cleaning:

Remember to clean data but not the voices of the marginal groups. For instance don't remove bad grammar or foreign words.

Analysis:

Remember to consult and refer to scholars from various groups.

Publication:

Though a market issue this one can be dealt by constant networking and calling our publications that are biased.

Feminist Research


Not even if you are google or planning a life time for your research.

But Gender is no conclusion of a good feminist research methodology.

There is a difference between experience and method. One need to know the method to resolve the problem of gender and other bias of the research.

Men often do not have this experiential knowledge, and therefore lack empathy, the ability for identification, and because of this they also lack social and sociological imagination (Mies 1983:121-2).

We see and think in terms of our culture...have been able to perceive, structure and understand our most intimate experiencing. Yet we have always another consciousness, another potential language within us, available to us. We are aware, however inchoately, of the reality of our own perceptions and experience (. . .) (DuBois 1983: 1 1 1- 2)

The best feminist analysis (. . .) insists that the inquirer her/himself be placed in the same critical plane as the overt subject matter (Harding 1987:9)

According to (the historical, dialectical and materialist theory of knowledge) the 'truth' of a theory is not dependent on the application of certain methodological principles and rules, but on its potential to orient the processes of praxis towards progressive emancipation and humanization (Mies 1983:124).

What we're trying to do is to point out that 'scientific knowledge', 'objective knowledge', are all social constructs, and as such are exactly similar to all other forms of knowledge-held-in-common. (. . .) Different states of consciousness aren't just different ways of interpreting the social world. We don't accept that there is something 'really' there for these interpretations to be interpretations of. Our differing states of consciousness lead us into constructing different social worlds (Stanley and Wise 1983b:130-l).

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Things to note

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Focus on methodology.

Even machine learning can be hierarchical if not properly pruned.

Read feminist research.

It is not a new field. Feminist interpretations of all major theories including the one of Marx and Freud is available.

Hierarchy is Multi dimensional.

When studying about leadership can you avoid the gender question?

There is a constant rejection of inequalities.

Why NASA could not have promoted the women scientist who wrote the code for moon mission?

Reject the authority of researcher.

Do not write what you think the respondent has said, write what the respondent has said because data is observational in character.

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
