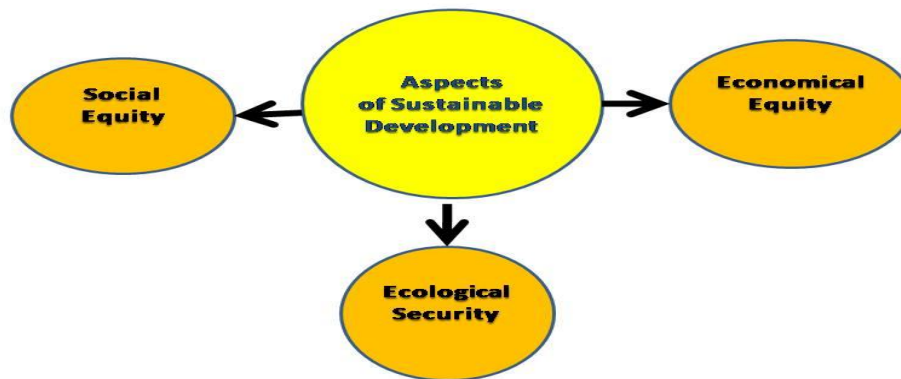


# Sustainable Development
